The historic facility has been renovated, yet still has the old time look of a 1950's professional baseball stadium. The backdrop mixture of residential and business surrounds the stadium and protrudes a calm and relaxing atmosphere for the players and spectators alike. The more than adequate sheltered seating with ceiling fans greatly enhances tournament viewing and spectator comfort.
